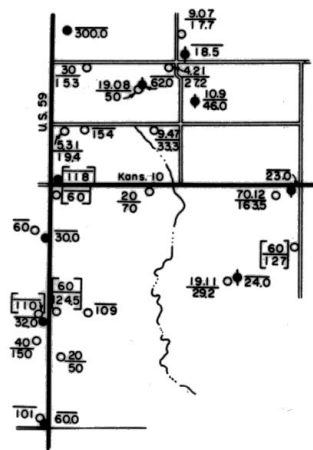
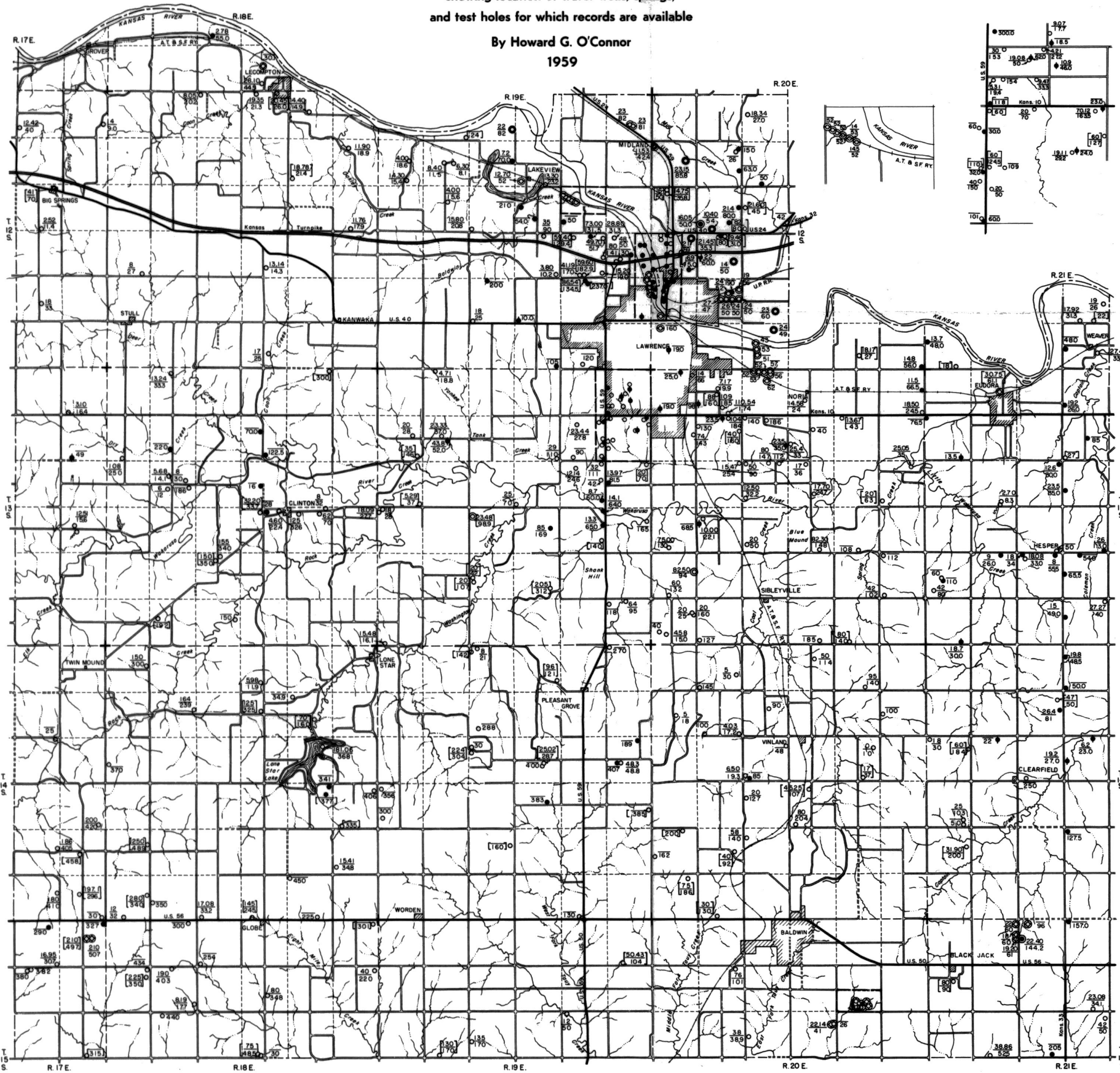


showing location of water wells, springs,

### EXPLANATION

- Lower number is depth of well below land surface, in feet. Reported depth shown to nearest foot, measured depth shown to nearest tenth of foot.
- Brackets indicate that water analysis is given in Table 5.
