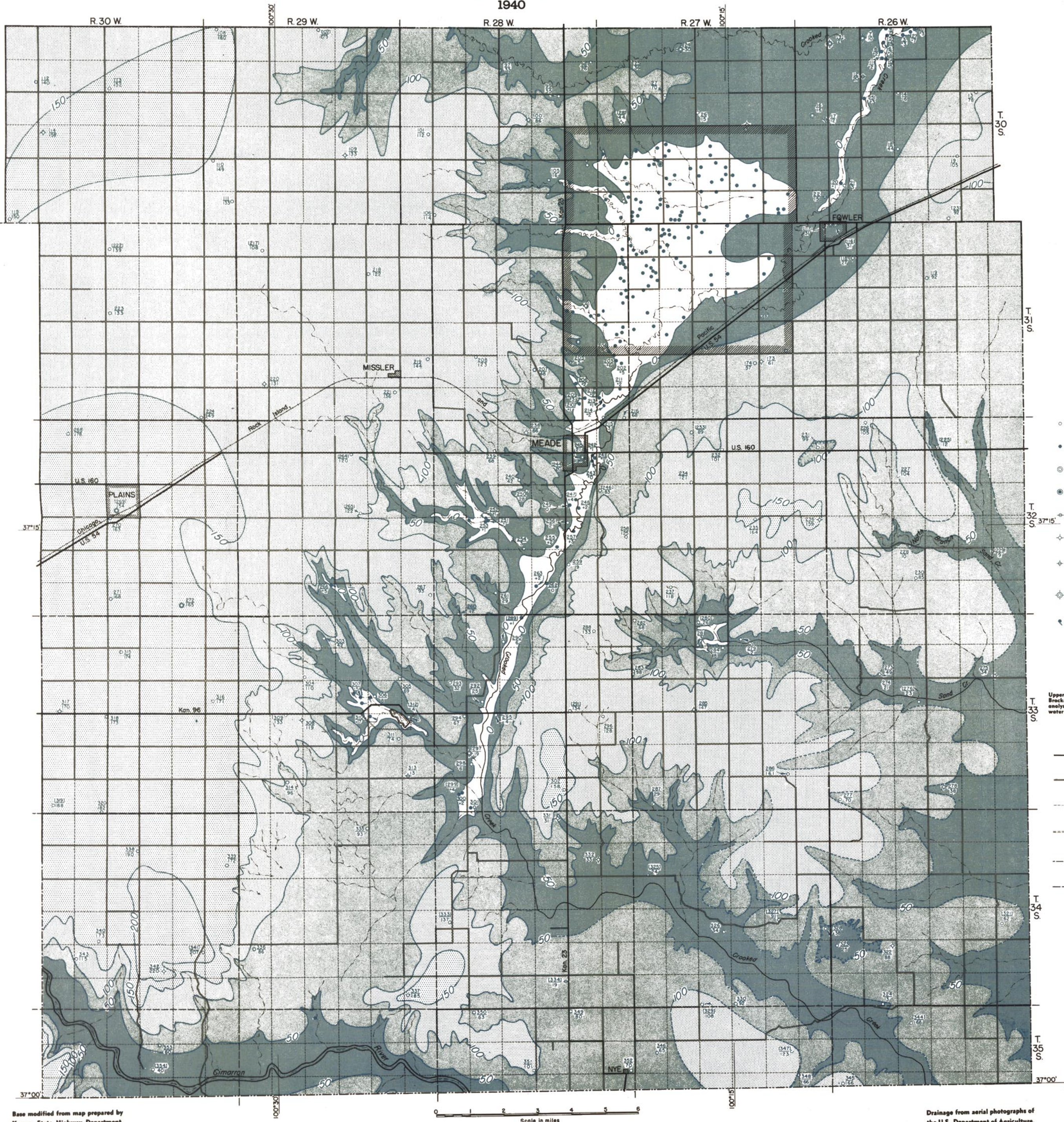


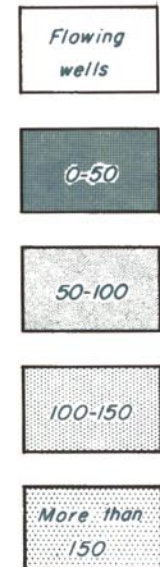
# MAP OF MEADE COUNTY

## EXPLANATION

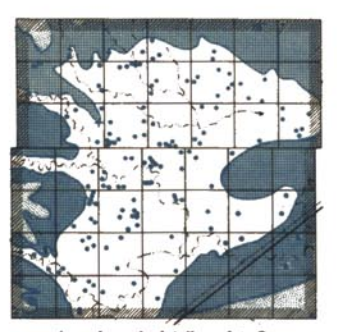


Depth to water level below
