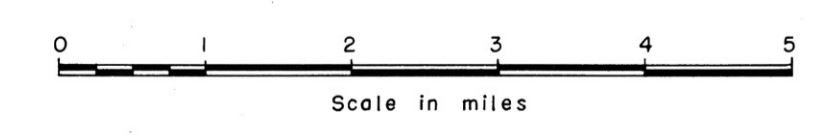

LOCATION OF WATER WELLS AND TEST HOLES
1947**

Explanation

- Generalized contour on the water table where it occurs in Tertiary or Quaternary deposits; contour interval, 20 feet
- Domestic or stock well
- Irrigation well
- Public supply well
- Observation wells
- Altitude of water level in flowing stream
- Upper number refers to altitude of water table
Lower number is the depth to water level in the well
Brackets indicate water analysis
- Location of test hole, log for which is given in this report
