

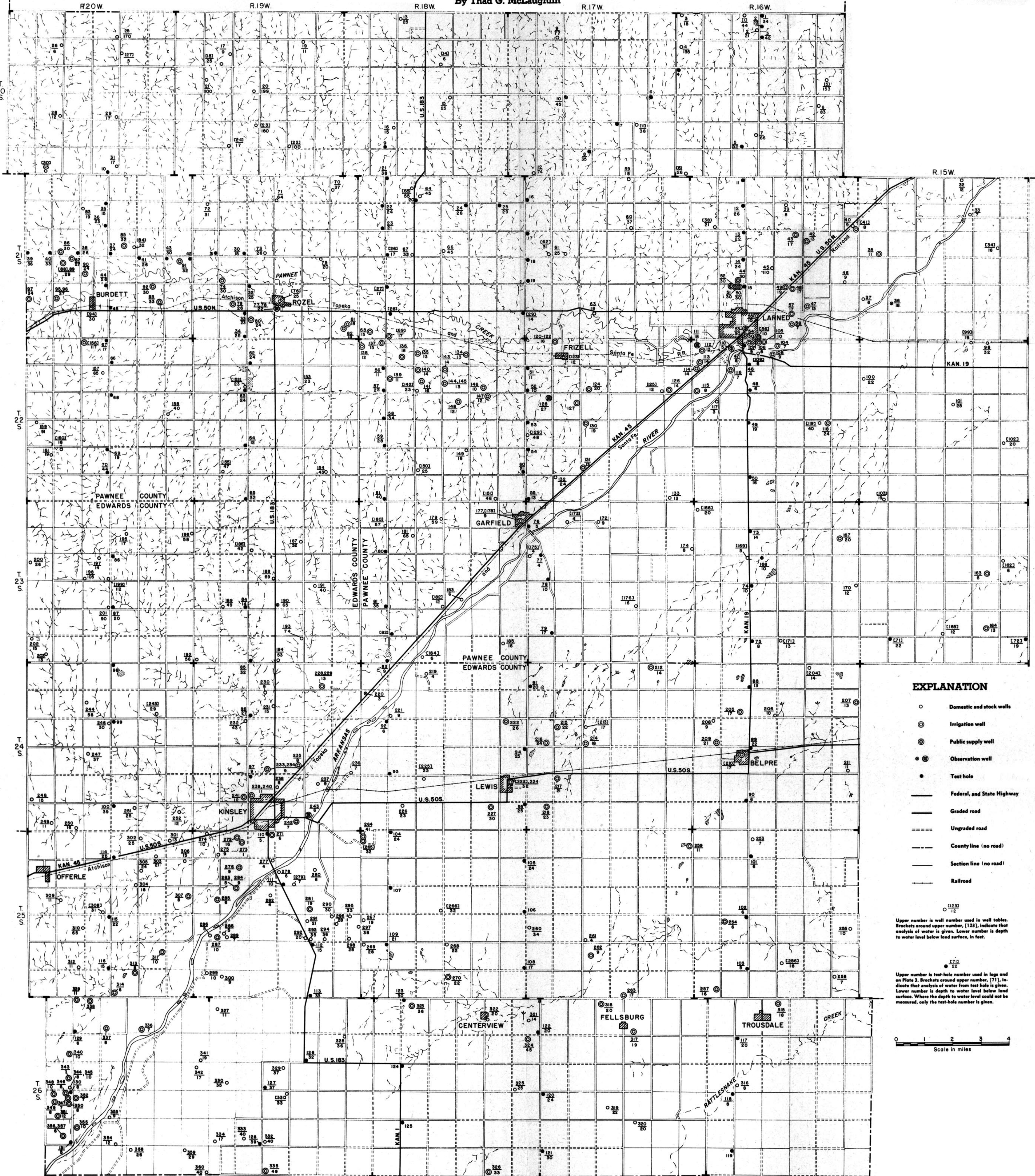
MAP OF PAWNEE AND EDWARDS COUNTIES, KANSAS

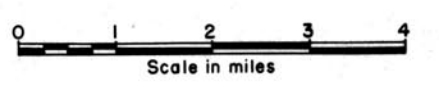


EXPLANATION

Upper number is well number used in well tables. Brackets around upper number, [123], indicate that analysis of water is given. Lower number is depth to water level below land surface, in feet.

Upper number is test-hole number used in logs and on Plate 3. Brackets around upper number, [71], indicate that analysis of water from test hole is given. Lower number is depth to water level below land surface. Where the depth to water level could not be measured, only the test-hole number is given.
