

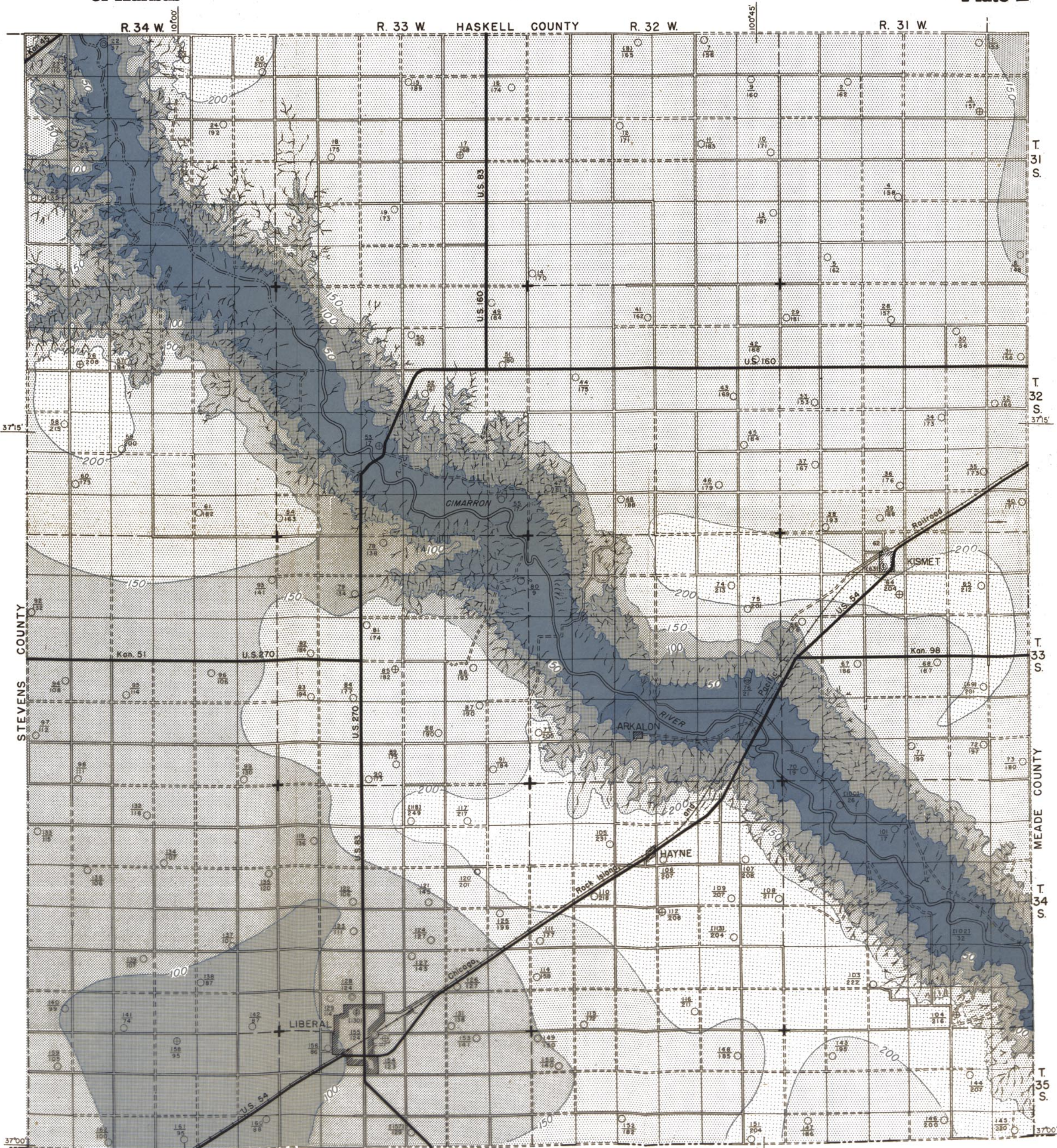
MAP OF SEWARD COUNTY

of Wells for which Records are given

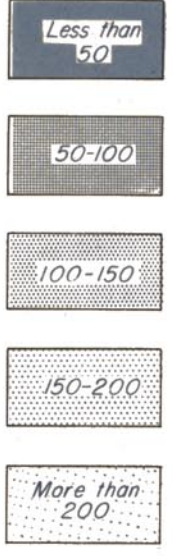
